# **GETTING STARTED**

## **Question #1**

Go round the group and briefly share what you understand to be the mission statement of our church.

How are we going with this?

## **Question #2**

What was the word Pastor Greg introduced on Sunday that is our vision for this year as a church?

Discuss what our church would like if we took on this word as individuals and as a church.

What things would need to change?

## **INTO THE BIBLE**

Read **Acts 2:42-47**

*Go back to the start of chapter 2 and discuss the events that have preceded this passage.*

### **Question #3**

This passage of scripture describes a church that is thriving! Read verse 42...what are the 4 main things they practiced as a church?

### **Question #4**

What was the outcome? (verses 43-47)

### **Question #5**

On Sunday we were all encouraged to fill out a card identifying areas we feel called to become involved in. Share what you believe your part is in the body of Christ at Yorkie.

### **Question #6**

Greg talked about the sort of church he would want to be a part of on Sunday. One where we see salvations happening, baptisms, and ones being disciplined. Do you agree? What is important for you to be happening at Yorkie?

## **DIGGING DEEPER**

### **Question #7**

Read Galations 5:25 in the NIV version.

What does it look like for us to be “in step” with the Spirit?

### **Question #8**

Spend time discussing what you think it means for us as individuals and as a church to travel from “here to here”.

Describe what the place we are in now looks like and where you think the Lord is leading us to.
