Question #1

What are your favourite Christmas stories? Discuss the different people involved in the larger Christmas story and how they play their role.

Question #2

What are your favourite Christmas Carols? Why? How do they relate to the gospel message?

Question #3

Read Luke 1:26-38 What stands out for you?

Question #4

Men put yourself in Joseph's position...how does it feel? Women put yourself in Mary's position...how does it feel?

Question #5

How is the Christmas season a good time to share the gospel with someone. John 3:16...others?

Question #6

Would you consider inviting an unsaved person to church this Christmas? What might make us hesitant to do this?

Question #7

What are some of the words of hope the Bible has at this time of the year for our world?

Question #8

Read Genesis 1:26 together. What does this tell us about God? Try and picture how creation would have looked.

Question#9

Read Luke 2:8-20. Have someone read it to the group then individually, marking questions and comments you may have.

Question #10

Do you find it strange that it was shepherds who were invited to visit Jesus? What do we know about shepherds? What was their reaction?

Question #11

What differences were there between the visits of the Magi and the shepherds?

Question #12

Discuss how all the characters in the story of Jesus birth were...the right people, in the right place, at the right time.

Question #13

Do you feel like you are the right person, in the right place, at the right time?

Question #14

Spend some time talking about how the wise men, and the shepherds left behind their normal lives to visit Jesus. What sacrifices are we willing to make to be in Jesus presence?
