MOPS

Is especially designed for mothers of pre-schoolers aged 0-6. Good food, good coffee, good friends, good discussions and good fun with top notch child care, guest speakers and creative activities. MOPS runs fortnightly on Wednesdays, 9.15am – 11.30am during the school term.

YORKIE KIDS
