Question #1

Question #3

Read Romans 12:1-11

Have someone read it out loud to the group. Then take time to read it quietly to yourself, marking down verses or words that stand out to you. Share these with the group.

Question #4

What do you think it means to be "in Christ Jesus"? Can you think of another verse that uses the same term?

Question #5

Discuss the difference between condemnation and conviction. Include discussion around how the Holy Spirit speaks to us as compared to how the enemy lies to us.

Question #6

What does it mean to be free in Christ Jesus?

Question #7

Have each member of the group express what their understanding of the role of the Holy Spirit is for today.

Question #8

Greg urged us to go deeper into the things of the Holy Spirit and ask to be continually filled as it says in Ephesians 5:18.

How do you feel about this, do you have any fears or reservations about going deeper?
