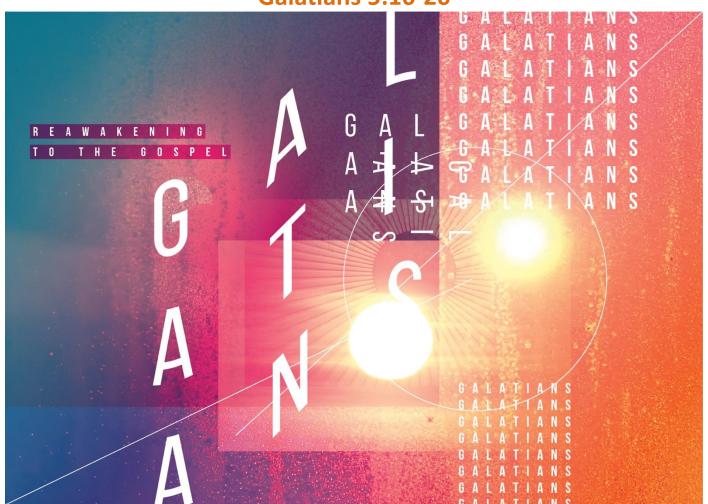

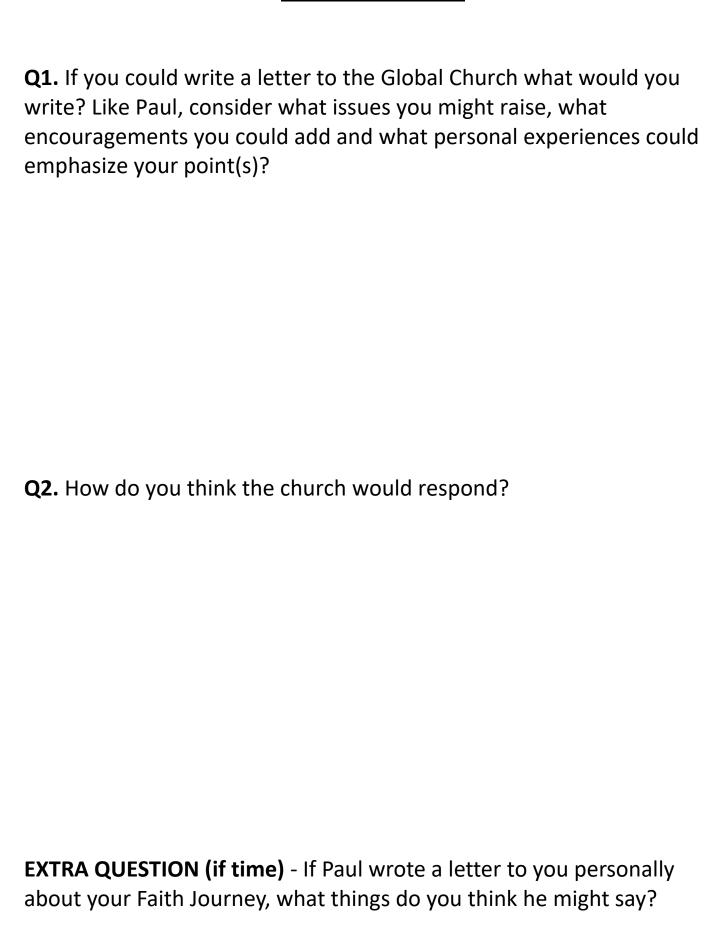

## THE FLESH

**Q5.** What things tend to distract you from living for God (from living in the Spirit)?

**Q6.** Ange said on Sunday that you can't have repentance without confession. Do you agree? Is confession a regular part of your faith? Why or why not?

**Q7.** What does the Bible say about confession? (Read 1 John 1:9, James 5:16, Proverbs 28:13, Romans 10:10)

#### FRUIT OF THE SPIRIT

**Q8.** What Fruits of the Spirit do you think our church excels in?

**Q9.** In what way do you believe you contribute to the INCREASE of FRUIT as an individual (or as a group) to our church community?

**Q10.** How does the Holy Spirit help us on our Spiritual Walk?

# **CONCLUSION & PRAYER**
