Q1. When you think of 'Home' what comes to mind?

INTO THE WORD

Read Hebrews 10:19-23

Q3. Hebrews was written to the Jewish Christians who knew the Old Testament well, they were saved through faith in Jesus Christ but were being tempted to revert to the old ways of living. What speaks to you in this passage in regards to the foundation of faith?

Hebrews 10:24-25

Q4. The Church is God's plan for the spreading of the Gospel, from the early disciples planting faith communities to the church of today. What commitments will you make this year to be a small group like that which Jesus demonstrated and the early church modelled (Acts 2:42-47)?

Hebrews 10:26-31

Q5. Jesus died for a purpose, the author of Hebrews does not hold back in explaining the reason for the incredible cost that Jesus paid on the cross for salvation. Much like the early church, we naturally 'revert back' to what is comfortable, yet Christ died for a purpose. How can we The Church live in response to what Jesus did on the cross?

GOING DEEPER

Hebrews 10:32-35

Q6. When you are standing for Christ there will always be opposition! It is not comfortable, not fun and not something that we look forward to, yet we see in scripture that we don't do this alone, we stand together, we stand united. How can you support one another as you make a stand for the Gospel of Jesus Christ this year?

Hebrews 10:36-39

Stand firm Church, live by FAITH, share the Good News with those you love, expect opposition, carry each other's burdens, and encourage one another.

Philippians 4:13 I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me.
