

John 21

GETTING STARTED

Q1. What are you looking forward to 'going back' to after restrictions ease?

Q2. For you, what is the difference between success as defined by the world, and life in Jesus?

INTO THE WORD

Read John 21:4-7

Q3. John was quick to see Jesus at work, Peter was quick to respond. Do you find it easier to recognise God working in you and in the world around you, or do you find it easier to respond to others pointing out what God is doing?

Read John 21:4, 10-14

Q4. This passage suggests they couldn't recognise Jesus simply from his appearance. How did they know it was Jesus? How do you know Jesus' voice in your own life?

GOING DEEPER

Read John 13:36-38, 18:15-18, 18:25-27, 21:15-19, Acts 2:38-40 **Q5.** Peter pretended to not even know Jesus, yet goes on to lead over 3000 people to believe in him. What does this mean for you?

John 20:31

Q6. The disciples needed Jesus to bring life to everything they did, the ordinary and extraordinary. How much do you allow Jesus to be a part of every part of your day?
