LET'S PRACTICE

Q6. Reflect on what things you can do personally to help you hear and discern God's voice.

Q7 Choose 1 or 2 questions to discuss together What do you think stands in our way of hearing God speak?

Do I struggle with discerning God's voice? How can I begin to practice listening now? What do I do when God is silent?

In closing - spend some time practicing hearing God's voice

- Read a passage of scripture OUT LOUD (Psalm 34)
- Re-read the passage quietly to yourself
- Ask God to show you if any words or phrases stick out to you
- Allow God to show you why He is pointing this particular section out to you
- Share what God showed you with the group
- Pray together over what God has spoken to you
