**Q4.** What barriers do we have today that people might put up against us teaching about Jesus? Paul pointed out Timothy's age, what barriers do we face?

**Q5.** Unpack the meanings of the words used in verse 12 to instruct Timothy (and us) on how to be an example.

**Q6.** Are the instructions given in this passage limited to Ministers/Pastors/teachers? Talk about the premise that we are all Ministers of the Gospel, also discuss how we put legs on this idea of us all being Ministers.

**Q6.** Share with the group the gifts and talents you see in one another. How are we using our gifts that we have received?
