
York St Small Groups Sermon Based Studies

GETTING STARTED

Q1. When we say "Jesus is our Lord and Saviour" what does that really mean?

Discuss what it looks like practically to have Jesus as the LORD of your life. Compare this with the notion of Jesus as 'saviour'.

Q2. What does 'household' look like for you? Start with those who you physically live with but think beyond that too. Who is in your 'sphere of influence'? Who is looking up to you? Who are you looking up to?

Q3. How do your statements of faith influence those around you?

INTO THE WORD

Read Joshua 24:14-15

Q4. What are some of the things standing in the way of the Israelites accepting God as their Lord? Are those things still relevant to us today?

Q5. What are some of the things in our current context that we see ourselves 'serving' instead of God? What are the things we prioritise over our relationship with Jesus?

GOING DEEPER

Q6. Are there elements of your past that you continue to hold on to, despite God's work on the cross through Jesus. How do you fully pick up your new life in Him?

Q7. If we consider *Luke 6:45*, what are those things "stored up in your heart"? How can you use these things to impact your 'household'?

Pray

Pray together as a group for those people in our 'households', pray for those that may not yet know Jesus.

Pray for the boldness to declare Jesus as Lord of our lives, submitting authority and control to him in all things.

Pray that through our interactions with those in our 'households', we might spur them on and encourage them in their faith journey.
