
York St Small Groups Sermon Based Studies

Q1.	What 'giants'	have you faced	in your life?
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Q2. What was it like to face those giants? What did you have to overcome? What did you learn?

INTO THE WORD

Read 1 Samuel 17

- Q3. Tim spoke on Sunday of the "H.E.R.O." idea being:
- H Hear the problem
- E Embrace God's plan
- **R** Identify your **Role**
- O The Outcome honours God

What stands out in this scripture of David's first encounter leading God's people that shows these "H.E.R.O." elements being played out?

Q4. I Samuel 17:48 speaks of David "running" towards the battle. What do you think gave David the ability to run towards the giant and how can we 'run' towards the giants that we face in our faith and life?

Read Matthew 26:41-42

Q5. While we would all like to think we can 'run' towards the battles in life often there is an 'inner battle' that needs to be fought before the real battle begins. Jesus exemplified this in the garden of Gethsemane. How can we learn from Jesus' example of how to win the inner battles that we face?

Q6. How can you support one another in your small group, or who can you ask for accountability and support this week to win the 'pre-battle,' as well as head into the battles to beat the giants in your life that take God's place as ruler in your life?
