Q4. How did the shepherds' reactions to the news of the Messiah's arrival compare to the religious leaders' reactions? What is significant about this contrast?

Q5. Have you ever had an undeniable encounter with God? If so, describe the experience. What made it so evident God was present? How did you respond to Him?

Q6. What keeps us from declaring the message of Jesus with the same abandonment as the shepherds?

Q7. How would you explain the true meaning of Christmas to someone who has never heard it? Who in your life may need to hear this?
