

GETTING STARTED

Q1. It's the start of a new year, and if you're like me, it's time for a fresh start, but before we can do this we must reflect on what worked and what didn't work in the previous year. What do you need to let go of before entering the new year? Fear, worries, health, safety of loved ones, resentment, anger, etc.

Q2. It's so important to remember and put into practice all that He's taught us. What are the three biggest lessons God taught you this past year? How can you continue to apply them in the coming year?

INTO THE WORD

Read Hebrews 10:24-25

Q3. In the new covenant our sins are paid for by Jesus' sacrifice. This gives us confidence to enter God's presence—but what does it have to do with meeting together and encouraging one another? How can we continue to gather within our current COVID restrictions?

Read Hebrews 10:19-25

Q4. What does this mean for our lives? In this passage, what five things are we told to do as members of the new covenant?

How do these relate to faith, hope and love?

Q5. Hebrews tells us that we should think about how to "provoke" one another to love and good deeds. What do other believers do that really motivates you to "love and doing good deeds"? Is God putting something on your heart this year that you should act on or need support with?

Q6. You are invited to refocus, revisit, re-examine the **ONE**. God has chosen **YOU** to be a part of the **ONE STORY**. This year how will **you** get involved? Will **YOU** set your mind on things above? How will you build the One Church personally and as a member of the Church family?
