Q1. Our first impressions on others can last a lifetime. How are you greeting others, and how do you think others perceive you?

Q2. How do you show love to every member? Are you seeing the new people in God's Church? How are you treating them?

Q3. What lengths are you going to share the Gospel, and are you striving to value others in the name of Jesus Christ?

INTO THE WORD

Read John 21

Q5. The resurrected Lord appears to some of His disciples at the Sea of Galilee. Did the disciples recognise Jesus at first? What was their reaction?

Q6. John 21:4

Why didn't they recognize Jesus when He called out to them? What else may have kept them from recognising Jesus?

Q7. Jesus asked Peter three times, "Do you love me?" as recorded in John 21:15–17. This occurred when Jesus was having breakfast with His disciples soon after His resurrection. Why is this important and what can we learn from this?

Q8. In John's final chapter 21, seven disciples are present for this last resurrection appearance, can you name all seven disciples?

PRAY

In your group, pray that God may enable each one of us to see people how he sees them. That as we open the doors of our faith community that we would be accepting, welcoming and supportive to everyone that walks through the doors.

Pray that in the in all areas of our collective ministry that we might consider the 'plus ones' in our areas of influence
