### GETTING STARTED

**Q1.** When did you give your life to Jesus?

If you are still in the process of discovering your faith journey, what significant spiritual moments in your life have you experienced?

**Q2.** After you accepted Jesus in your life, what changed? Alternatively, what characteristics do you think Christians have and why?



# INTO THE WORD

## **READ: JOHN 15:9-15**

**Q3.** God commands us to come from a place of love (Genesis 20, Mark 12:30-31). How have you experienced God's love in your life?

**Q4.** If God's love is so transforming, why do you think many Christians don't share the 'Good News' with others?

**Q5.** Exercise: Draw a line across the page, the starting point is age 0 and the end point is your current age. Along the line draw some dots or lines at age points where you can recall something significant in your spiritual journey. E.g. someone told you about Jesus, or you attended church for the first time. Spend some time looking at how God has worked in and through your life. Spend some time thanking God in prayer.

## GOING DEEPER

### **READ: JOHN 4:4-30**

**Q6.** This well-known story of Jesus and the Samaritan woman shows how God's character of "loving your neighbour" is expressed by Jesus. There are multiple parties in this book, Jesus, the woman, the disciples and the Samaritans. What perspectives do you think they all had on one another based on this passage alone?

**Q7.** Why do you think the woman's testimony was so powerful? (John 4:39-41)

**Q8.** What story do you have to share about what Jesus has done for you? How can you point others to Jesus?
