GETTING STARTED

- Why does Luke think it is important to tell us that Zacchaeus is a tax collector and that he has become very rich?
- How do people cheat people in today's culture? How do people cheat God? Consider the modern-day 'tax collectors'.

INTO THE WORD

LUKE 19:1-10

- Jesus goes home for lunch with Zacchaeus and verse 9 begins with, **“Salvation has come to this home today.”** What kind of conversation did they have over lunch that would have prompted Jesus to say this?
- When Jesus invited himself to Zacchaeus' home, Zacchaeus “took Jesus to his house in great excitement and joy.” Would your response have been the same or different? What do you admire most about Zacchaeus? Why?

GOING DEEPER

- How do you think Jesus knew Zacchaeus' name? When did it begin to dawn on you that Jesus knew your name before you knew who He was?
- What do you admire the most about Jesus? Why? If Jesus were to have a heart-to-heart conversation with you during lunch, what do you think He would encourage you to do?
