GETTING STARTED

- **Humility:** How can humility manifest in our family interactions? What are some practical ways to show humility towards family members?
- **Generosity:** How can we cultivate a spirit of generosity within our families? In what ways can we be more intentional about sharing our time, resources, and love?
- **Faithfulness:** What does faithfulness look like in the context of family life? How can we remain steadfast and supportive to our family members through challenges?

INTO THE WORD

Nehemiah 1:4-11; 2:1-8; 5:14-19; 6:15-16

- **Humility:** How did Nehemiah demonstrate humility in his approach to the King and his leadership in Jerusalem? Consider his initial response to the news of Jerusalem's state and his actions upon arriving in the city. What does this reveal about his character?
- **Generosity:** Reflect on Nehemiah's decision to use his own resources rather than burden the people of Jerusalem with additional taxes (Nehemiah 5:14-18). How does this act of generosity contribute to the well-being of the community? What can we learn about generosity from Nehemiah's example?
- **Faithfulness:** Nehemiah remained committed to his mission despite significant opposition and challenges. How did his faithfulness impact the rebuilding of Jerusalem's walls? How did his dedication inspire others? What does this teach us about faithfulness in our own lives?

GOING DEEPER

Nehemiah 2:11-20; 4:6; 6:1-16

- **Humility:** Nehemiah's inspection of the walls and careful planning before sharing his vision with others (Nehemiah 2:11-16) demonstrates humility. How does humility affect the way we lead and influence our families? What are some ways we can practice humility in our family roles?
- **Generosity:** Consider Nehemiah's actions to address the complaints of the poor and his refusal to leverage his position for personal gain (Nehemiah 5:14-19). How can we apply these in our daily lives? How can we create a culture of generosity within our families?
- **Faithfulness:** Reflect on how Nehemiah's steadfast faith and resilience against opposition (Nehemiah 6:1-16) led to the successful completion of the wall. How can we embody this kind of faithfulness in our family relationships and responsibilities? How can we support each other in maintaining faithfulness amidst trials?
