GETTING STARTED

- Think of a time when you felt truly welcomed somewhere. What made that experience special? On the other hand, have you ever felt unwelcome? How did that impact you?

Today, we'll explore what it means to welcome others as Christ welcomes us and how we can cultivate a habit of being present in church this year.

INTO THE WORD

Read Romans 15:7.

YOU Are Welcome

Romans 15:7 reminds us that Christ has welcomed us—not because of our merit, but because of His love.

- **Read Ephesians 2:19-22.** How does this passage describe our place in God's family?
- How does knowing you are welcomed by God impact your relationship with Him and others?

You Are to Welcome Others

- **Read Hebrews 13:2 and Matthew 25:35.** What do these verses teach about hospitality?
- Think of someone who made you feel welcome at church. What did they do that stood out?
- Is there someone in your church or neighbourhood who may need to experience God's love through your welcome? How can you reach out to them this week?

GOING DEEPER

Read Hebrews 10:24-25.

- Why is gathering with other believers important?
- What distractions or challenges make it difficult for you to attend church regularly?
- How can you set a godly rhythm this year to be more consistent in attending and welcoming others?
