Key Verse: John 15:1-2

GETTING STARTED

Vision Sunday is a time to refocus on where God is leading us. Just like a vine needs pruning to grow stronger, we need to allow God to shape us for what's next.

- What does "vision" mean to you in the context of your faith?
- Have you ever gone through a season where God seemed to be "pruning" you? What was the result?

INTO THE WORD

Read John 15:1-2.

Jesus' metaphor of the vine and branches teaches us that growth requires connection and care. The Father, as the gardener, removes what hinders our growth and strengthens what is fruitful. This is true for both individuals and churches.

- In what ways do you see God pruning and shaping your life right now?
- How does staying connected to Jesus (the Vine) influence your ability to bear fruit?

God's vision for us isn't just about where we are today—it's about what's next. Pruning can be uncomfortable, but it prepares us for greater things. As a church and as individuals, we must trust God's process.

- What is one step of faith you feel God is calling you to take next?
- How can our small group support each other in staying connected to Jesus?

GOING DEEPER

Spiritual growth isn't a one-time event; it's a lifelong process. We must keep coming back to Jesus, remaining in Him daily. Vision Sunday is not just about looking ahead but committing to remain in Him every step of the way.

- What practical steps can you take to remain connected to Jesus in your daily life?
- How can Vision Sunday be a reminder to keep seeking God's direction?
