GETTING STARTED

Life is not meant to be lived alone, and spiritual growth is not a solo journey. God designed the church as a body—where each part is needed and valuable. As we seek “What’s Next?” in our faith, we must recognise that we grow best together.

- When have you experienced the power of working together rather than alone?
- Why do you think spiritual growth often happens more effectively in a community?

INTO THE WORD

Paul challenges the Corinthians to mature in their faith and move beyond spiritual infancy. Likewise, we are called to grow and serve together.

Ecclesiastes reminds us that we are stronger when we stand side by side.

Read 1 Corinthians 12:12-27

- What does Paul say about spiritual immaturity?
How does division hinder growth?

Read Ecclesiastes 4:9-12

- What are the benefits of being spiritually connected to others?
- What do these passages reveal about the dangers of isolation in our spiritual journey?
- How can you take steps to grow with others rather than staying stuck spiritually?

GOING DEEPER

Growth isn't a one-time decision—it's a lifelong commitment. Just as we need each other, we also need to keep showing up, serving, and encouraging one another. The enemy loves isolation, but God calls us to keep coming back to community, fellowship, and purpose.

- What gifts or strengths do you have that could encourage or support someone else?
- What barriers keep you from consistently engaging with your faith community? How can you overcome them?

PRAY TOGETHER

Lord, thank You for designing us to grow together. Help us move beyond immaturity and embrace the strength that comes from unity. Reveal our gifts and give us the courage to use them for Your glory. May we keep coming back to You and to each other as we walk this journey of faith. Amen.
