MOTHER'S DAY: SEEN IN THE UNSEEN 11 May 2025

Key Verses: Colossions 3:16-17

GETTING STARTED

Many believers quietly serve, love, and remain faithful without recognition. You may feel unseen by people—but Scripture reminds us that God sees every act of love, service, and worship done in His name. "Seen in the Unseen" reminds us that the spiritual impact of our lives often happens beneath the surface, yet it is profoundly significant in the eyes of God.

Discussion Questions:

- Have you ever done something important or meaningful but felt like no one noticed?
- What helps you keep going when your efforts feel unseen or underappreciated?

INTO THE WORD

Read Colossians 3:16-17 (NIV)

"Let the message of Christ dwell among you richly as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom through psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit, singing to God with gratitude in your hearts. And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him."

Discussion Questions:

- "Whatever you do... do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus" How do we glorify God in everyday actions that may seem routine or unnoticed?
- Why is singing or worshiping with gratitude powerful, even when done alone or without recognition?

Even when no one sees our obedience, gratitude, or encouragement, God does—and these unseen acts of faith make Christ visible to others.

GOING DEEPER

Discussion Questions:

- Are there areas where you've been serving or giving faithfully but feeling invisible or unappreciated?
- How might this passage encourage you to keep going, knowing that God sees the unseen?

Application Challenge:

- Identify one way you're serving, loving, or giving that feels unnoticed—and commit it to God this week as an offering of worship.
- Reach out and encourage someone else who might feel unseen in their faith or service. A simple word could remind them they matter to God.

PRAYER

"Lord, You see what others don't. Help me live with Your eyes in mind, not the approval of others. Teach me to find joy in the unseen moments, and to trust that my faithfulness is precious to You. Let everything I do reflect Your name, whether or not it's ever recognised by others."
