INTO THE WORD

The New Testament begins with the arrival of Jesus—the Word made flesh. He comes not in isolation, but as the fulfilment of centuries of promises. His first words in Matthew are a call to repentance, signalling a new Kingdom breaking in. His life, death, and resurrection reveal that the long silence was never abandonment—God was at work behind the scenes, preparing the way.

 How do the promises of the Old Testament come alive through Jesus' story?

GOING DEEPER

Genesis 12:3 & Galatians 3:8 – The blessing to all nations.

 How is Jesus the fulfilment of God's covenant to Abraham?

Isaiah 53:5 & Luke 24:46–47 – The suffering servant and the Gospel.

 What does Isaiah's prophecy reveal about the nature of Jesus' mission? How did Jesus explain this after His resurrection?

Matthew 4:17 & Romans 12:1-2 - A new way of life

- What does it mean to truly repent?
- How does Kingdom living transform our daily choices?

John 1:14 & Colossians 1:15-20 - The Word became flesh.

- What does it mean that Jesus is the visible image of the invisible God?
- How should that impact how we see Him and ourselves?
