GETTING STARTED

We all stand on the shoulders of those who came before us—parents, mentors, leaders, and faithful men and women of God.

Just as they invested in us, we now carry the responsibility to invest in others.

Legacy is not just about what we leave behind, but about how we live today.

Icebreaker question:

- Who is someone who has invested into your spiritual journey, and how has that shaped your life?

INTO THE WORD

1. Legacy is Built on God, the Rock

Read Psalm 18:2, Isaiah 26:4, Matthew 7:24-25, 1 Corinthians 3:11.

Our foundation must be Jesus Christ, the unshakeable rock. Anything else will eventually crumble.

- Question: What foundations in your life are built on Christ? Are there areas you need to realign with Him?

2. Legacy is About Passing It On

Read Psalm 78:4-7, Proverbs 13:22, 2 Timothy 2:2.

Faith is never meant to stop with us. We are called to tell the next generation, to invest in others, and to entrust the gospel to reliable people who will teach others.

- Question: Who has God placed in your life right now that you could intentionally invest in?

3. The Model of Jesus: Disciples Make Disciples

Read Matthew 28:19-20 and Luke 6:12-16.

Jesus chose twelve, trained them, and sent them out to multiply His mission. Discipleship is not addition—it's multiplication.

- Question: What practical step can you take this week to follow Jesus' model of discipling others?

4. Legacy Involves Investing in People

Read Philippians 1:6.

We honour those who invested in us by doing the same for others, trusting that God will complete the work He begins. Mentoring can be simple: walking alongside someone, offering love, accountability, and encouragement.

- Question: How can you make space in your life to invest in someone's faith journey?

GOING DEEPER

Imagine York Street Church of Christ 100 years from now. What story will be told of this generation? Will people say we built on Christ, loved Him deeply, and boldly served His kingdom? Legacy is written one decision at a time—your next step matters.

- Reflect: What could be the eternal impact of your personal legacy and that of our church?
