

INTO THE WORD

Q3. Read Luke 15:1-7

Jesus challenges the church of the day by getting them to think about what God wants over what we want. How do we resemble the shepherds in the story? How does Jesus represent the shepherd?

Q4. Read Luke 15: 8-10

In this story Jesus talks about a lost coin, the focus in this story compared to the other is the effort that is taken to 'find' the lost coin. As Christians we can cut ourselves off from those who are not saved, what can we do about this?

GOING DEEPER



In this story we see a broken relationship, and a restoration of that broken relationship. What do we see in this story that resonates with your acceptance of Jesus Christ?

Q6. If different to the previous question, how did you come to faith? What would you say if someone asked the question "how can I follow Jesus?".
