INTO THE WORD

Read Matthew 13:31-33

Q4. What stands out to you in this passage?

Q5. Is there a common theme in these two parables?
What is it?

Q6. What is God's Kingdom? Explain what God's Kingdom is in your own words.

Read Matthew 17:20

Q7. Where have you seen this in action in your life?

Q8. What does a little bit of faith look like for you?

Read Ezekiel 36:26

Q9. Reflect, and if comfortable share with the group how you have been transformed by God through Jesus' death and resurrection.

Read Matthew 22:37-38

Q10. What does it look like for you to love God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind?

GOING DEEPER

Let's be a church who gives back to God what He has given us to continue to grow His Kingdom.

Q11. What little bit of faith, idea or gift do you have that God could use to grow His Kingdom?

Q12. If you feel comfortable sharing with the group, what is one thing that you believe God is calling you to do that you have been holding off doing? What is stopping you?

Matthew 5:16 says; "In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven."

Spend some time praying for one another and that God would give you the faith and courage you need to let your light shine before others for God's glory. Ask that God would use you, your faith in Him and the gifts He has given you to do big things for His Kingdom here on earth.
