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## **GETTING STARTED**

**Q1.** Decisions can offend change our lives' and the lives of others around us. Do you consider if your decision will affect other people and if so, how? or what am I sacrificing because of my decision? or am I acting in a responsible manner?

**Q2.** We can't always plan the outcome of our decisions, sometimes people can be hurt by the outcomes. What's your response? How do you think Jesus would response?

## **INTO THE WORD**

### **Read John 1**

**Q4.** Read John chapter 1, What is the passage saying? What does this tell me about God? How should you live your life based on what you have read?

**Q5.** There is 'One Story' that we are a part of, and it's His Story, we were designed to live in the light, to walk in the light, to follow the light and that light is Jesus. "Why Easter important? why is Jesus important? why is our relationship with Him important?"

**Q5.** John was born to serve God. What is your life's God-given gifts? God-serving mission? Are you living out that mission? If not, why not?

## GOING DEEPER

### **Q6. Read John 14:7**

While we can not be with God due to our sinful actions, God came to us in Jesus. How can we treat Jesus knowing that he is God and how can we praise God through the Holy Spirit?

**Q7.** Gods story means that we are created for relationship with God and with Others (Matt 22:37). If God set the example by giving what he loved for us, how can we give what we love to others, how do we live knowing the cost that love paid through Jesus?

Heavenly father may we love as you loved us, may we give as you gave for us, may we walk with others in the way that you walk with us. May we know your presence in how we follow your example of loving sacrificially, generously, and with all that we have, in your name we pray. Amen
