

Q1. Our perspective changes everything. When you think of church, what comes to mind? When you think of family, what comes to mind?

Q2. Who and what influences our perception? How can we influence others' perceptions?

NTO THE WORD

Read Hebrews 10:24-25

Q3. Earthly things come and go, but the things of God will last forever. If you were to look at your life and the way you live, would it reflect Christ? Are there areas in your life that need to be reexamined?

Read Romans 12:1 -21

Q4. If we want to follow Jesus, we must fully surrender ourselves, our ideas, our ambitions, our expectations, and our attitudes to Jesus. It is in this that we are open to listen to and put into practice the teachings of Jesus.

What do you need to hand over to him this week?

Q5. Faith means following Jesus into the mystery of God. Faith is filled with curiosity that longs to be satisfied, and faith compels us to imagine what God has in store for our lives.
