INTO THE WORD

EXODUS 2:1-10

 Moses' sister Miriam plays a crucial role in the well-known history of Israel, but likewise she takes a humble role in working behind the scenes. In this season of life do you feel like you are a Moses or Miriam? A faith to lead through the hard seasons or a faith to lead from the sidelines or behind the scenes in serving others?

GOING DEEPER

EXODUS 15:20-21

 Miriam was a prophet and a leader (Micah 6:4), however we don't hear of her leadership up until this part of scripture. Often our service for God goes unseen, it's what takes place behind closed doors that shows Godly character. How do you honour God when no one is looking?

- Miriam's example of leadership was also found in worship, when was the last time you were so overwhelmed by Gods love and grace that you led others in worship? (remember worship is not just singing, but living for God).
- This season, lets live by faith, leading our own relationship with Him behind closed doors, but also by leading others by living a life of worship to God.
