GETTING STARTED

- Can you remember meeting someone who had every right to be broken, downcast, or bitter, but instead was so positive that they brought life to others?

- Can you remember a time when you had to work through something that happened to you to focus on God's goodness once again?

INTO THE WORD

JUDGES 11:1-3

- Jephthah had a rough beginning to life, his family disowned him, and he had no social status yet he was known as a leader and warrior. God looks past the circumstances, at the heart. How is your heart for God?

- Our Judge Jephthah had such character that others gathered around him (v3). Who do you have gather around you and how do you influence them with the gospel?

GOING DEEPER

Read Judges 11:27-40

- In verse 35 we read of the inner conviction that Jephthah had, he made a vow and he knew what he had to do because of his foolish words. Can you think of a time you had to serve God even though it was difficult?

Not only was our main character born into a dysfunctional family, but he ensured that his own family followed God. We read in v36 that his daughter also had such character that she would follow through with what her father had vowed.

- How are you investing in your children or the next generation in a way that helps them love and respect God with the conviction of Jephthah's daughter?

Pray together as a group for Godly character that transcends our circumstances and that will impact the next generation with the gospel.
