# INTO THE WORD

## **ESTHER 4:9-17**

- We read in the earlier chapters that Esther was made Queen, and that Haman was out to destroy the Jews, we see that Esther (a Jew) goes to God first after trying to help her father Mordecai. When all else fails we go to God, can you think of a time when you tried to do something yourself and then had to go to God?
- Esther had others pray for and with her (Esther 4:16). Who do you have around you to pray for God's wisdom in and through hard situations or times of praise? If you need people what can YOU do to gather Godly people to support you?

# GOING DEEPER

## Read Esther 7:3

- Chapters 5-7 in Esther speak of the plan God gave Esther, it also speaks of God's intervention (Esther 6). While God's name is never spoken in the book of Esther, He is still very active. Can you think of a time when you thought God was silent yet you know He was active and working in your life or the life of someone else?
- Esther took a huge risk in speaking to the King, but she did what was right. What does doing what is right look like for you no matter the cost?
