GETTING STARTED

The prophet Isaiah foretold the birth of Jesus, calling Him “Wonderful Counsellor.”

INTO THE WORD

Isaiah 9:6

Isaiah 9:6 describes the coming Messiah with powerful names. Let's explore:

1. Wonderful

- The Hebrew word for "wonderful" (פֶּלִיאַ, pele) means extraordinary or beyond comprehension.
- Psalm 139:14 – "I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made." How does Jesus' wonderful nature give us hope and assurance?
- Matthew 8:27 – The disciples asked, "What kind of man is this? Even the winds and the waves obey him!" How does this story show Jesus' wonder?

2. Counsellor

- A counsellor provides guidance and wisdom. Jesus is our divine counsellor, offering eternal truths.
- Proverbs 3:5-6 – "Trust in the Lord with all your heart... He will make your paths straight." How can trusting Jesus guide our decisions?
- John 14:26 – The Holy Spirit, sent by Jesus, teaches and reminds us of God's truth. How does this promise comfort you?

GOING DEEPER

Jesus, as Wonderful Counsellor, meets us in our struggles and uncertainties. Reflect on these questions:

- When have you experienced Jesus' guidance in your life?
- How does knowing Jesus as “wonderful” and “counsellor” change how you pray or seek Him daily?

Consider challenges you're facing.
How can Jesus' wisdom and wonder help you navigate them?
