Key Verse: John 15:9-17

GETTING STARTED

Jesus calls His followers to abide in Him and bear fruit that lasts. But what does that look like in our daily lives? As we grow in faith, we must ask, "What's next?"

- Think about a time when someone showed you deep love. How did it impact you?

- What does it mean to remain (or abide) in Jesus' love?

INTO THE WORD

Read John 15:9-17.

Jesus tells His disciples to remain in His love and love one another. He also says they are His friends and have been chosen to bear fruit that lasts.

- In verse 10, Jesus connects love and obedience. How does obedience help us stay connected to Jesus?

- Jesus calls His followers “friends” (v. 15). How does this change how we view our relationship with Him?

GOING DEEPER

The fruit Jesus speaks of is the result of living in Him—our character, actions, and influence on others. This fruit isn't temporary but eternal. Loving others as Jesus loves us is one way we see this fruit in our lives.

- What kind of "fruit" do you see in your life right now? How does it reflect Christ's love?

- What are some practical ways you can keep coming back to Jesus daily?
